CSAL Player Contract and Athletics and Activities Parent's Pledge

STUDENT - SIGNIFICANT RULES

1. Any pupil who participates on an organized team outside of school from the first day of CSAL practice to the conclusion of the post season tournaments, shall be ineligible for school teams in that sport.
2. Any player joining a CSAL team must do so before the first scheduled game of the regular season. The only exception to this rule would be a student transferring from another school.
3. CSAL students are to be held to high behavioral as well as academic standards. Students who are suspended will not be allowed to participate in practice, games or contests for a minimum of one week. Grades will be figured each week during the season. If a student has a cumulative "F" in any subject they will be will ineligible for a least the next week. While ineligible, students will be allowed to practice, but cannot suit up for any games or contests. If a student receives a second "F" at any time after this first ineligibility period, he/she may be ineligible for the remainder of that sport season.
4. The above standards do not preclude the authority of the Principal to limit, suspend or prohibit students from participation in practice or games for behavioral problems as they deem necessary.

I understand that in order for me to participate on a CSAL team I must agree to review and follow the eligibility rules of the CSAL.
