In literature this week we talked about how people in a community cooperate. We read the story of "Miss Bintergarten Takes a Field Trip With Kindergarten." Her class went to the library, the fire station, the bakery, the post office and the park. We drew pictures today of where we would most like to visit. The park and the fire station were the most popular places! We are also learning about classifying things, rhymes, and letter V.

In Math we learned more about ordering and comparing numbers zero to five. Today I gave each table group a different number and they had to put themselves in order.

In science we are continuing to learn about the five senses which God gave us. Today we talked about the sense of taste. We got to taste sweet (chocolate and oranges), sour (lemons), salty (crackers), and bitter (baking chocolate) things. I'm sure you can guess the favorite thing.
