## Reminders from the School Nurse



Welcome to All Saints Catholic School! We all hope it will be a very good year for you and your child. **Just a few reminders as we start the year out:**

- If your child needs to take any prescription medicine at school, **you must** fill in a form for us to give it. **This form needs to be re-done every year.** The office and your child's primary doctor have this form for you. **We cannot** give any medications without a signed form! I have been sending emails out starting in April 2025 – please check the email you provided the school (the one listed in PowerSchool) regarding medications during the school day for your child.
  - If your child is on a medicine, **the form will need to be signed by the physician for us to give it at school.**
- If your child will be taking a controlled drug (such as Ritalin) at school, you must bring this medication every month in person. It is illegal for children to carry these medications in their backpack.
- If you would like to bring in over-the-counter medicines like Tylenol, Motrin, cough syrup, COUGH DROPS, etc, I will store them for you during the school year with your child's name, date of birth and current grade level for the 2025-2026 school year, and I will use it as needed. **You still must fill out a permission slip and give me instructions as to when it should be used.**

**The following is very important: Make sure you have given us several phone numbers to reach you in case your child gets sick or has an accident. It is absolutely essential that we be able to contact you at all times. Make sure you have filled out the emergency information completely and update us during the year of any phone number changes.**

- A fever is 100.4 or above. Your child should not come to school with any temperature of 100.4 or over. Please do not give your child Tylenol and then send him/her to school. (\*\*\*)Please see parent handbook for further information)
- Please do not send your child to school if they have vomited in the morning.
- **You must notify the office if your child will not be attending school. The number is 316-682-6021**
- Please ensure your child starts the day with a good morning meal. This morning meal will give your child the boost they need to start learning first thing in the morning.
- Please know you are welcome to call the school nurse (call school office and ask for school nurse), email or stop by to discuss further questions or concerns (if stopping by, please email ahead of time to ensure nurse is in office). I look forward to caring for your children and working with you this year.
