Week of November 9 - 13

We have had some beautiful fall afternoons to be outside and enjoy God's world. Some of the children have enjoyed finding bugs, leaves, and milkweed pods outside. Our nature box on my desk is full of their treasures.

In literature we learned about what bears do in the winter. Our story was about a bear sleeping in his cave during a snowstorm. Other animals came in out of the cold and had a party while he slept. Ask your child what happened when the bear woke up! We talked about the setting of stories. We are also learning about adjectives. Our letter of the week was "li." Next week we will be learning about letter "Tt" and our new high frequency words will be "my," "we," and "like."

In math we have been learning about comparing and ordering numbers one to ten. It has been challenging for your children to learn the concepts of greater than and less than, 1 and 2 more, and 1 and 2 fewer. Figuring out what numbers are greater than five and less than ten is also hard. Please help your child learn these things. We will be doing some more lessons on them next week.

In science we have been learning to describe different objects based on color, shape, and size. We also learned to recognize what materials they are made of and whether they are rough, smooth, hard or soft.

In religion we are learning that God gave us feelings, and he understands how we feel. God loves us no matter how we feel. It is good to talk about our feelings with others. In Second Step we learned about what we should do if we accidentally hurt someone else.
