In literature last week we learned more about informational text. We read a book about visiting an art store, and then compared it to a book we read earlier about the library. We discussed the main points of the books, and the details that we learned about the topics.

Phonics lessons were focused on letter P, rhyming words, and identifying the first sounds in words. We continued to work on reading high frequency words. Our new words will be *we*, *my*, and *make*. Our new letter will be Bb.

In math we are learning about numbers six to ten. In science we are learning about pets and how we care for them.

In religion we are learning about the virtue of faith, which can be defined as believing what God has revealed. We are also learning that God made all people everywhere. We are continuing to say our prayers daily.
