This has been a good week to learn about weather and the seasons. With beautiful sunny days like today, we appreciate what a wonderful season autumn is. With record lows and snow flurries like earlier this week, we are reminded that winter is coming.

This week in religion we learned that God gives us friends and when he gives good gifts, we should say “thank you.” We heard the Bible story of Jesus healing the blind man, and observed the blind man’s good example of thanking God for his sight. In Second Step we talked about some steps we can take to calm down when we are upset.

In literature we began a new unit about “Changes All Around Us.” Our story this week was about a baby panda at the San Diego Zoo who grew and changed as she grew older. We learned more about letters “c” and “k”, began learning high frequency words “was,” and “you,” and worked on sounding out/decoding three-letter words.
