### Composer-of-the-Month



**Johann Pachelbel**

- Lived 1653-1706
- Nationality - German
- Style/Period - Baroque

Johann Pachelbel wrote many sacred and secular works during his lifetime as a composer, organist and teacher. He is best remembered for his *Canon in D*. It is an example of one of his many works composed using variation forms and techniques. His contributions to the development of the chorale, prelude, and fugue, as well as his influence on younger composers have earned him an importance place in the Baroque era.
