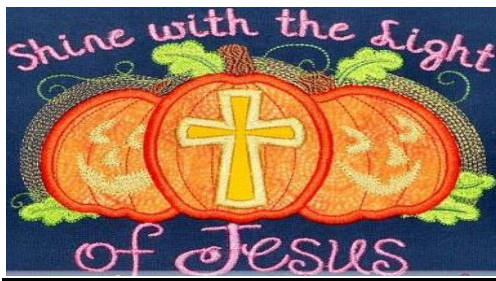


# OCTOBER 2021 NEWSLETTER
